Tobacco Free Schools



All schools in Clay County, Missouri have tobacco free building and campus policies.

Clean Indoor Air Cities



This is a smoke-free restaurant & bar



North Kansas City, Kearney, Kansas City, Gladstone, Liberty, and Excelsior Springs have all passed a Clean Indoor Air Ordinance.



In the KC Metro area *outside* of Clay County, Clean Indoor Air Ordinances have been passed in Lee's Summit, Independence, Grandview, and Blue Springs.

Clean Indoor Air Coverage



As of December 2016, **86.3%** of Clay County residents reside in cities that have clean indoor ordinances in place.



To reach **90%** of residents covered, passing an ordinance in unincorporated Clay County or a combination of smaller municipalities would achieve this goal.

Tobacco 21



Liberty, Gladstone, Kansas City, and Excelsior Springs have passed Tobacco 21 ordinances (which includes sales of e-cigarettes).



These four ordinances cover **80.6%** of the Clay County population.
