



RECREATIONAL WATERS: SIGNAGE RULES

These rules may be conveyed by any combination of words, pictures, or symbols.

1. In case of an emergency, dial 911 or follow other emergency instructions.
2. All persons should take a shower before entering the water.
3. Patron Load:
4. Running or boisterous play is not allowed on the deck.
5. No diving [at swimming pools without an approved diving well configuration].
6. Glass items are not allowed in or around the swimming pool.
7. Animals are not allowed in the pool and no animals on the deck, except for service animals, if applicable.
8. No person with open cuts, sores, lesions, infections or obvious communicable disease shall use the swimming pool including if you are ill with diarrhea or have had diarrhea within the past 2 weeks.
9. Children must be supervised by a responsible adult up to the minimum age established by the facility operator.
10. Location of nearest telephone for emergency use or emergency notification procedure.

13. Diaper changing on the deck is prohibited.
14. Pollution of pool is prohibited.
15. Do not swallow or spit water.
16. Intentional hyperventilation or extended breath holding activities prohibited.

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SPA SAFETY SIGNAGE & RULES

In addition to other signage requirements, spa shall have these additional rules posted:

1. Maximum water temperature is 104°F.
2. Children under age 5 and people using alcohol or drugs that cause drowsiness shall not use spas.
3. Pregnant women and people with heart disease, high blood pressure or other health problems should not use spas without prior consultation with a healthcare provider.
4. Children under the age of 14 shall be supervised by an adult
5. Use of the spa when alone is prohibited (if no lifeguards on site).
